Confirmation at First (Scots) typically
occurs during the student's eighth grade
year. Older students who have not joined

participate as well. This program teaches
the essentials of the faith and prepares
each Confirmand to publicly profess faith
in Jesus Christ and become an adult
member of the church. This class is
conducted by James Rogers and adult
Confirmation Guides during the Sunday
School hour from September through April.
Service projects and retreats are also a
part of the program. Classes are based
on the *We Believe Professing Our Faith*
curriculum by PCUSA, and the students join
the church on the first Sunday of May
during the 11:15 AM worship service.
