COVENANT:

As a youth mission team member, I will covenant to:

- Participate in Fundraising Activities. Raising money for our trip is part of being involved in mission work. Each member is expected to participate.
- Listen and obey ALL adults on the mission trip to Jamaica. While we have not had an issue with safety, listening and being obedient to Adult Leader directions is a must for the benefit and safety of all.

Also, I realize:

- This is a mission trip and not a vacation. The point is service to our Lord and others we meet.
- I am expected to participate fully in the work day, the evening programs, small groups and family group times.
- Serving God mean serving each other. It's sacrificial.
- This trip might change my life forever.
- Drugs, alcohol, tobacco products and weapons of any kind are not allowed on this trip.
- I am expected to treat others as Children of God (with respect and love).
