Missions & Outreach

Missions Matter: Frontier Fellowship



The Christian frontier is any place on earth where the Gospel of Jesus has yet to find expression. From the Darfur region of Sudan, across the sands of North Africa to Niger, up to Persia and over the Kirthar Mountains to Pakistan, the Frontier Fellowship supports, educates and equips the followers of Jesus to make His name known in lands where there is no indigenous church.

The stateside staff is very small – just one full-time and two part-time employees in the Minnesota office. But the field staff includes dozens of missionaries working in almost 20 countries, often where Christianity is dangerous or illegal. The Fellowship prefers to work through local missionaries – men and women who were born into the cultures they are called to evangelize. Thus, most of their projects focus on theological and practical training for pastors and church leaders, support for local churches, or living expenses for native church planting teams.

Pray for Ethiopia. The southwestern regions of Ethiopia are home to numerous unreached peoples. One of our partners, the Jimma Bethel Synod (JBS) of the Ethiopian Evangelical Church Mekane Yesus, serves in five key regions south of Jimma: Menja, Tsara, Dawro, Ameya and Kaffa. Many people in these areas live in fear of evil spirits, and JBS is eager to introduce them to the hope and freedom Jesus offers. Funds for the Frontier Fellowship help JBS share the Good News through traveling evangelists, leadership training for women, youth initiatives and outreach to university students and Muslims.
